Description of street/alley sought to vacate: West side of 13th Street South, between Travis Street and Hyde Street. This request pertains specifically to Badger Property parcel 17-50266-010		
Reason for Request: Badger currently maintains these parking stalls under a separate Street Privilege Permit. If the City were to approve and vacate the ROW, Badger would assume full responsibility for the maintenance of the stalls. This action would provide a clear and permanent solution that aligns, with City policy. In addition, it would maintain parking that Badger employees utilize daily.		
A vacation of a public way is the process of discontinuing public use and returning dedicated public right-of-way to private property. Upon discontinuance, the right-of-way reverts to the owners of the adjoining land where the discontinued land originated or is equally divided between the owners on either side of the centerline of the discontinued public way. See statutory requirements (§66.1003, Wis. Stats) and the City's process.
