***Re: Shared Sanitary Sewer – 1003 King St. & 1009-1011 King St.***

Dear Ms. Erickson:

I wanted to send an updated letter to you for the Board of Public Work's information prior to Monday's 10 am meeting. We have been in discussions with the other property owner (the Greens) and their attorney and this letter is sent jointly for both parties. We have some cost estimate information for a new lateral for the furthest property (the Mathison property) but due to its location and the fact that the lateral needs to go all the way to 10<sup>th</sup> Street instead of simply to King Street, we believe this to be the most expensive option. Mr. Green (1003 King Street) is researching the possibility of a new lateral from his property to determine whether it can be done, and for what cost.

The parties, jointly, ask for a 60-day extension to research and finalize a plan to move forward to separate the properties from the shared sanitary sewer system.
