RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Sanitary Sewer Utility is required to perform a full review of the sanitary sewer rate structure at least every five years.

AND WHEREAS the current sewer rate review has been completed by John A. Mayer, Utility Rate Consultant, as summarized in the attached EXECUTIVE REPORT dated August 14, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby accepts the EXECUTIVE REPORT from John A. Mayer and approves the proposed changes to sanitary sewer rates as summarized in Schedule 1, Pages 1 and 2 of the EXECUTIVE REPORT, and authorizes the Sanitary Sewer Utility to implement new charges effective January 1, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council that the method for billing residential sewer charges during summer quarters is hereby revised to require billing the lower amount of actual water usage or 125% of water usage during winter quarters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Public Works, Director of Finance, and Utilities Manager are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
