*Shared lane repainting coming from Parks maintenance fund - must take into account condition of pavement, too. CIP may cover 17th St improvements in other categories; repaving 7 blocks in 2017. Gallager and staff to collaborate on 2016 project list to include in resolution to release funds. City could do high visibility crossing at West/Vine instead of Pine. There were no bidders on Clinton St. road diet - Engineering will rebid this winter.*

Miller made a motion, Hogan seconded, to direct Traffic Engineer and Planning staff to create a resolution releasing funds for 2016 projects. The motion carried by voice vote.

- 4 **22nd Street Neighborhood Greenway planning discussion**

*Committee discussed doing full length of 22nd bike Blvd; Schelfout requested plan for crossing State Rd. with a preferred crossing at Adams. Miller suggested wait for example of 17th St. before planning other blvds. Engineering is reconstructing Adams St. in 2017.*

Young made a motion, Miller seconded, to direct Traffic Engineer to design Adams St. as a pedestrian street between 21st St. and State Rd. and with consideration for greenway elements between State Rd and Losey Blvd. The motion carried by voice vote.
