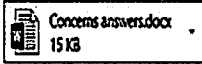

Community Concerns	Franciscan Community Resource Center
Shelter for the Homeless or those on the verge of homelessness.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - It is a Day Resource Center, not a night shelter. - Programming will revolve around a service delivery model for the entire community not just a place for homeless people. - Hours of operation will be from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday
A place where people "hung out". Often times, loitering on or near the property.	<p>No loitering will be allowed. People participating in the activities of that day will be inside the building. Those who are not will not be allowed to "hang out".</p> <p>How will this be achieved:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cameras will be installed outside to monitor the area. No one will be allowed on the premises after hours. The Police will be called. • Regular sweeps of the building and block by staff and volunteers • Staff will coordinate with the Police Department and Resource Officers to ensure this is the case through increased monitoring of the neighborhood • Guests of the Resource Center will be aware of the rules upon entry and the enforcement of these rules
Garbage and needles strewn about the outside of the building and surrounding areas	<p>Staff and volunteers will walk the block daily to ensure cleanliness of the neighborhood and do our part of being a good neighbor. Again, no loitering will be allowed so that should minimize or eliminate any problem in this area.</p> <p>Smoking will not be allowed inside the premises.</p>
Clients that refuse services	<p>Clients that refuse services will be referred to the County's Human Services Dept. or the Police</p>
No real programming. Only a place of hospitality.	<p>Community-wide programming and services will be available in the building. The entire community and neighborhood will benefit. There will be something for everyone.</p>
