ORDINANCE NO.:5313
AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 36-68 (b) and create Subsections 36-38 (c), -(1), and -(2) of the Municipal Code of Or-

-(2) of the Municipal Code of Or-dinances of the City of La Crosse, regarding the Brush Site. WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse previously defined and established an operational Brush Site at part of Vibilio Working of The Computer of Computer of the most recently updated August 14, 2023 via Chapter 36, Article III, Sections 36-56, -54, and -68 of the Municipal Code of Ordinanc-es; and

es; and WHEREAS, said legislation did establish various aspects of the Brush Site, including definitions, standards, and guidelines for operations, but did not include establishment of user-based fees

establishment of user-based fees and funding; and WHEREAS, after decades of permitted operation, serving thou-sands of residents and owners or property in the City of La Crosse, and producing tons of compost, and próducing tons of compost, woodchips, and sustainable pow-er fuel, it is prudent to continue to assess observed conditions, performance, and capacity, and to consider and implement appropriate practices for resiliency and the long-term future of services for the general health, safety, and welfare of the City of La Crosse. Consecution of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Subsection 36-68
(b) is hereby amended added as follows:

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(b) Large items shall not be placed for collection by the City. Disposal of large items shall be the sole responsibility and at the sole expense of the parcel owner. Brush may be taken to a Board of Public Works approved brush site from City properties and in accordance with City policies and in accordance with City policies. accordance with City policies and procedures for use of the brush site. Non-woody yard waste-shall be composted on site of its origination or delivered to a City yard waste site during open hours. City residents may arrange for City residents may arrange for private yard waste services from a private contractor at their sole expense.

SECTION II: Subsections 36-68 (c), (1), and (2) are hereby created as follows:

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(c) Brush ms; be taken to a
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City yard waste site during open
hours. City residents may arrange
for private yard waste services
from a private contractor at their
sole expense.
(1) The establishment of user
permit flees shall be per Appendix
C - fee schedule.
(2) The collection of revenue
shall be directed to a designated
fund, from which any expendi-

shall be directed to a designated fund, from which any expenditures shall be restricted to maintenance, equipment, supplies, and security (non-labor) for Brush Sites established by the Board of Public Works.
