

Resolution approving City of La Crosse Three-Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions – 2015.

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the attached Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions describes proposed improvements which are in the best interest of the La Crosse Harbor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, in accord with State statute, requires a statement of project intentions from local units of government intending to apply for federal and/or state aid for harbor related work of any type within the next three years; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has carefully reviewed the estimated project costs, funding sources, physical location, and alternatives to the proposed project(s); and

**WHEREAS**, the total local matching funds required for projects indicated as being funded through the Wisconsin Harbor Assistance Program ranges from \$ \$20,837 (20%) to \$ 289,407 (50%), the latter being if U.S. Army Corps of Engineers financing is involved; and

**WHEREAS**, this Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions is used by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for planning purposes only and is not a petition for federal and/or state aid;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse approves the attached Harbor Development Statement of Intentions.
