Dear Randy,

Midwest Fuels is requesting City of LaCrosse Board of Public Works approval of an Alley surfacing project adjacent to Midwest property and located between Sumner St. and Copeland Ave. from Hagar St. to St. Andrew St.

The scope of work to complete this Alley surfacing project would include the following:

- 1. Sawcut and remove existing asphalt pavement at the driveways and parking lots along both sides of the alley as needed to create adequate construction joints.
- 2. Salvage the existing gravel/recycle base material.
- 3. Establish grade for positive drainage.
- 4. Regrade the sub-grade and haul out excess material as needed.
- 5. Place salvaged gravel/recycle material and import gravel base as needed to provide for a minimum of an 8" compacted layer of gravel.
- 6. Fine grade, water and compact the gravel base layer and prepare the area for Hot Mix Asphalt paving.
- 7. Place  $2 1 \frac{3}{4}$  compacted lifts of Hot Mix Asphalt.
- 8. Place gravel base or topsoil along edges of the new Alley surface as needed.
- 9. The alley would be designed with an inverted crown for the majority of the length of the alley and would transition to the west side of the alley on the north end.
- 10. Layout of Alley is shown in the Attached PDF.

Midwest Fuels would be covering all costs for the scope of work items noted above and Mathy Construction Co. would be contracted to complete all of this work. We would tentatively schedule this work to be completed in Sept. or October of this year and Midwest Fuels would provide advance notice to all neighbors of scheduled work, if approved.

Please place Midwest Fuels request on the Agenda for the upcoming Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup> Board of Public Works meeting.

Midwest Fuels Vice President, Mr. Joel Reinhart and I will attend this meeting to answer any questions regarding this proposed project.
