It has been determined at this time that the Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department will not move forward with the development of Creekside Place Park. Financial and logistical challenges are the primary concerns with a planned development. Additionally, the department has concerns with the proposed location and its proximity to two high volume roadways.

In an attempt to address the concerns raised at the March 9th meeting of the Board of Public Works regarding access to Roessler Park, the department will continue to look into redeveloping an access trail that once existed from Hickory Nut Court. While it is unknown at this time what a redevelopment will entail, the department understands the importance of access to Roessler Park especially for the neighborhood youth.
