AN ORDINANCE to amend Table 111-13(1) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding allowed sign characteristics.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

Section I: Table 111-13(1) included within Section 111-13 is hereby amended to read as follows:
Table 111-13(1). Allowed Sign Characteristics

Sign characteristics of all allowed signs shall be regulated in accordance with the following standards:

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the article shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
