ALTA stated they assisted staff with requesting \$100,000 for 2025 Capital Improvement Plan funds to implement a Quick-Build Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Program. This program would include using low-cost materials to implement treatments such as curb extensions or other bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements. These are permanent, cost effective solutions to create safer Bicycle and Pedestrian pathways throughout the city.
