I wanted to say removing parking on 3rd and 4th will be a huge detriment to downtown businesses. At all hours of the weekday those parking spots are full, I know because many a student has been late to lessons due to not being able to park anywhere near the building, sometime Is even at 8pm at night. If their grandparents are bringing them or a couple parents are somewhat disabled, it's even harder if they need to park farther away to try and get to the building. Also, I haven't seen hardly any bikes using the designated bike lanes in front of the Center so why would removing the convenience of street parking in favor of bikes be helpful? It would not.
