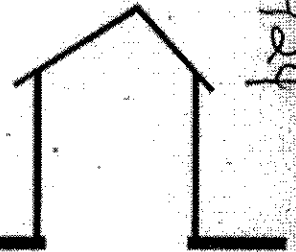

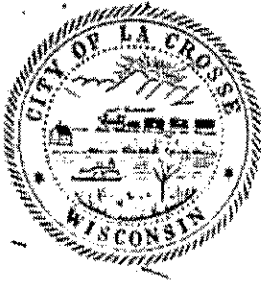

The Board of Park Commissioners at their adjourned meeting of February 23, 1978, unanimously recommended the proposed property exchange between the Housing Authority of La Crosse and the City of La Crosse Board of Park Commissioners.

The proposal requested by the Housing Authority is to trade approximately one and one-half (1½) acres of Forest Avenue Park for approximately a ten (10) acre site near Taylor and Hamilton Streets on the far north portion of the city.

The requested trade is conditional on the recognition of the ten (10) acre tract as park land, and that the Housing Authority will agree to grade the area, to smooth out the present irregular landscape.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the request of the Housing Authority of La Crosse to obtain the North portion of Forest Park from the City of La Crosse in exchange for 10 acres of land owned by the Housing Authority at the North City limits be and the same is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the land is obtained from the Housing Authority of La Crosse the said property shall be used by the City of La Crosse for public park purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed to the City owned portion of Forest Park being conveyed and are authorized to accept a deed of conveyance from the Housing Authority concurrently.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of the exchange the Park Department shall arrange removal of the house and barn situated on the property being acquired by the City and shall arrange for and undertake necessary grading of the property.
