

Resolution declaring certain property located in the Spier & Canterbury's Addition as Surplus City Industrial Property.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse owns a number of parcels in the Spier & Canterbury's Addition, more specifically parcels 17-10142-100, 17-10142-130 and a small remnant.

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works declared these parcels as surplus property not needed for the City's public use, and


WHEREAS, Riteway Bus LLC has expressed interest in acquiring the property to aid in their facility plans,

WHEREAS, the City has force sanitary sewer main and an Old Town North directional sign on the parcels,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the aforementioned parcels as depicted and described on the Plat of Survey are declared surplus, to be offered for sale to Riteway Bus, LLC at a price determined by the City Assessor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Finance Director, City Attorney, Director of Planning and Development and Board of Public Works are hereby authorized to effectuate this resolution.
