Resolution approving a modification to the Employee Handbook to provide on-call pay for the position of Computer Specialist.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Resolution # 13-0836 approved the Employee Handbook for SEIU and Non-Represented Employees, and

WHEREAS, any modifications to the Employee Handbook with a negative financial impact require Common Council approval, and

WHEREAS, the Employee Handbook specifies positions which are eligible for a \$50 per week "on-call" pay, and

WHEREAS, the position of Computer Specialist needs to be included as an eligible position for on-call to provide evening and weekend coverage for IT emergencies, and

WHEREAS, "on-call" pay is limited to one non-exempt staff member per week.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council that the position of Computer Specialist be added to eligible positions for on-call pay effective June 1, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Human Resources, Director of Finance, Director of Information Technology are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to implement this resolution. Funding for the on-call pay shall come from the Information Technology Departments operating budget.
