2. Complete and submit the application.
3. Parks and Forestry Staff will review and represent the application through the approval process
4. Once approved, get started at your spot right away!

BEAUTIFY LA CROSSE

A program inviting citizens to take part in creating a more aesthetically pleasing and sustainable landscape throughout La Crosse

PURPOSE

This is an opportunity for individuals, neighborhood groups, business, clubs and other organizations to “adopt” an area within a neighborhood and do as much or as little desired. Participants can establish a new planting bed, or water, weed, and restore an existing area.

PROJECT IDEAS

- **Plant a micro-prairie in your boulevard**
- **Establish a rain garden**
- **Adopt a planter box in a park or landscaped area**
- **Plant native plants in traffic circles**
- **Develop a pollinator garden in your neighborhood**

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 50% of the plants used in new plantings must be native to our area
- Plantings in road right-of-ways are restricted in height to 30 inches or less (not including trees)
