What is a StoryWalk?

A StoryWalk® is an innovative and delightful way for children — and adults! — to enjoy reading and the outdoors at the same time. Laminated pages from a children's book are attached to metal poles which are installed along an outdoor path.

StoryWalks® have been installed in 50 states and 13 countries including, Germany, Canada, England, Bermuda, Russia, Malaysia, Pakistan and South Korea.

Who will be responsible for the condition of the StoryWalk?

The La Crosse Public Library will be responsible for keeping the StoryWalk in good condition. We will change the books seasonally and manage any damage, wear and tear, or vandalism that might occur.

Where would this be located?

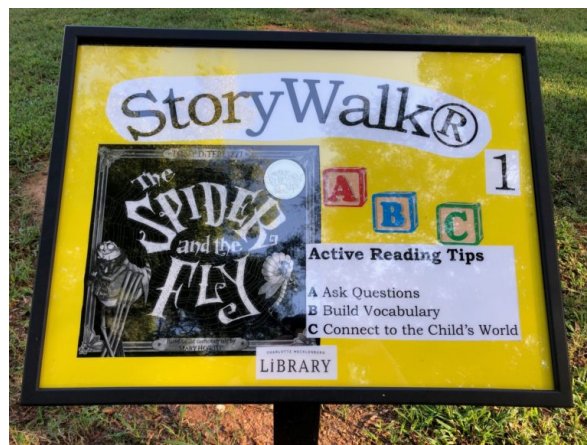
We envision this Storywalk on the Chad Erickson Connector Trail.
