Resolution denying application of Chloe Seelig for a Beverage Operator's License and appeal of denial by the Police Department

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Application of Chloe Seelig for a Beverage Operator's License and appeal of denial by the Police Department is hereby denied in accordance with the recommendation of the City of La Crosse Police Department for the following reasons:

That the applicant does not qualify to hold a beverage operator's license due to the following reasons:

- (1) That pursuant to Wis. Stats. §125.04(5)(a)(1), the application does not qualify to hold a beverage operator's license due to past arrest and conviction record.
- (2) That pursuant to Wis. Stats. §125.04(5)(b) the applicant does not qualify to hold a beverage operator's license because the applicant is a habitual law offender.

Furthermore, the Judiciary and Administration Committee and the Common Council of the City of La Crosse further finds and determines that the past arrest and conviction record(s) substantially relates to the licensing activity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant may reapply for a beverage operator's license no earlier than six (6) months from the date of this decision, if no further violations are obtained.
