

Resolution appropriating funds for the public market feasibility and site location study.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse and the Redevelopment Authority submitted a request for proposals for a public market feasibility and site location study and chose to move forward with the response from Public Market Development which estimates the total cost to be \$129,800; and

WHEREAS, the 2006-2010 Capital Improvement Program as approved by the Common Council, allowed for borrowing for projects intended for economic development; and

WHEREAS, there are remaining funds from this borrowing as the projects were either completed under budget or via other sources, and


WHEREAS, City staff is applying for public grants for the remaining funding of this study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the reallocation of 2006-2010 Capital Improvement Program funding as follows:

\$77,995.32 2006-C Taxable Promissory Notes – Miscellaneous

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Planning and Development and Finance Director are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
