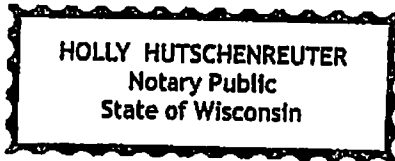

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Resolution authorizing public improvement and levying special assessments against benefited property in La Crosse, Wisconsin - Water Main: 1600 block of Hayes Street and 1500 block of Cunningham Street

AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, a report was prepared and adopted by the Board of Public Works on the proposed public improvement consisting of Water Main at the following:

1600 block of Hayes Street
 1500 block of Cunningham Street

WHEREAS, the assessments against benefited properties, and said report, are on file with the City Clerk, and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2020, the Finance and Personnel Committee of La Crosse, Wisconsin held a public hearing for all interested persons concerning the report of the Board of Public Works, this resolution and proposed assessments against benefited property, and all persons who desire to speak at the hearing shall be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, that it determine as follows:

It is expedient and necessary and for the best interest of the City of La Crosse and for the property affected hereby, that said properties be improved at the expense of the property benefited by the construction of a sewerage-ebbey-pavement water main.

The Common Council exercises its police power to levy special assessments upon property for benefits conferred upon such property. The report of the Board of Public Works, incorporated herein as it fully set forth herein, including plans and specifications and assessments set forth herein, is adopted and approved.

The Board of Public Works shall advertise for bids and supervise construction of the improvements in accordance with the resolution adopted and take such other and proper steps to effectuate this resolution. Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefited as indicated in the report.

The Common Council determines that assessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power for the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its inhabitants and have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.

Assessments may be paid in cash or shall be payable over a period of ten (10) years or fifteen (15) years to the City Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate established by the Common Council per annum on the unpaid balances from January 1st of the year following the levy.

The City Clerk shall provide notices in accordance with City Ord. 38-1. Adopted by the Common Council: 2/13/2020
