

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION, FIRST RESPONDER, RESCUE AND INSPECTION SERVICES

This Second Amendment to the Agreement for Fire Protection, First Responder, Rescue and Inspection Services ("Second Amendment") is made by and between the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin ("City") and the Town of Medary, Wisconsin ("Town") on April 5, 2019.

WHEREAS, the City and Town entered into an Agreement for Fire Protection, First Responder, Rescue and Inspection Services dated March 14, 2018 (the "Agreement"), which term expired on December 31, 2018, and which was subsequently extended to March 31, 2019;

WHEREAS, the parties would like to further extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein exchanged, and other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term.** Paragraph 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the term until June 30, 2019 at 11:59 p.m.
- 2.** In consideration for the extended term as provided in Paragraph 1 of this Second Amendment, the Town shall pay seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) to the City on or before April 30, 2019, respectively. During any extended term, the Town shall continue to pay the City standard inspection fees as provided in Paragraph 1 of the Agreement.
- 3. Other Provisions.** Except as described herein, all other terms, conditions, covenants and promises of the Agreement and all exhibits thereto shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
- 4. Authority to Sign.** The person signing this Second Amendment on behalf of Town certifies and attests that they have the full and complete authority to bind Town, on whose behalf the person is executing this Second Amendment.
- 5. Miscellaneous.** The Agreement for Fire Protection, First Responder, Rescue and Inspection Services, as amended by this Second Amendment, remains in full force and effect and is binding on the parties' successors and assigns. This Second Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which are considered one and the same amendment notwithstanding that all parties hereto have not signed the same counterpart. Signatures of this Second Amendment, which are transmitted either or both by electronic or telephonic means (including, without limitation, facsimile and email) are valid for all purposes. Any party shall, however, deliver an original signature of this Second Amendment to the other party upon request.

IN WITNESS, the parties to this agreement have caused this instrument to be signed and sealed by duly authorized representatives of the City and Town.
