The Council exercises its police power to levy special assessments upon property for benefits conferred upon such property.

The report of the Board of Public Works, incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and approved. The Board of Public Works shall

advertise for bids and supervise construction of the improvements in accordance with the report hereby adopted and take such other and proper steps to effectuate this reso-

Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefited as indicated in the report.

The Council determines that as-sessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power for the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its in-habitants and have been deter-mined on a reasonable basis and

are hereby confirmed.

Assessments may be paid in cash or shall be payable over a period of ten years or fifteen years to the City Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the placed for sellection and shall due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate established by the Council per annum on the un-

paid balance from January 1st of the year following the levy.
