

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON  
AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse by its Judiciary and Administration Committee will hold a public hearing upon the proposed change in the zoning ordinance hereinafter set forth. Such public hearing will be held at **7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 31, 2016** in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

The City Plan Commission of the City of La Crosse will meet to consider such ordinance on **Tuesday, May 31, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.** in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Room in City Hall and final action will be determined by the Common Council on **Thursday, June 9, 2016 at 7:30 p.m.**, both in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the Office of the City Clerk.

Such proposed change set forth in the ordinance now pending before the Common Council of the City of La Crosse is as follows:

***AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by transferring certain property from the Residence District to the Low Density Multiple District.***

***Address: 2006 Weston Street.***

***Proposed Use: Place of worship, community gathering and residence of Clergy.***

***Proposed Rezoning is Necessary Because: Rezoning is necessary to allow future property improvements such as an additional garage/storage building, new parish hall and parking lot.***

Said property is further described as follows:
