ORDINANCE NO.: 4998
AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 44-71 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse concerning the speed limit on Losey Boulevard.
WHEREAS, the speed limit on Losey Boulevard is currently set at 30 miles per hour. By eliminating the current ordinance exception, the speed on Losey Boulevard will revert to the speed set forth in Wisconsin Statutes, Section 346.57(4)(e), which is 25 miles per hour.
THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:
SECTION I: Section 44-71(1)(c)1 is hereby repealed.
SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.
SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.

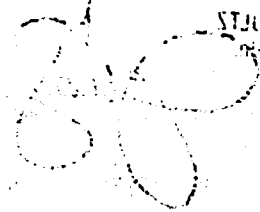
