

Coulee Region Hunger Walk/Run/Bike

“We walk with our neighbors to end hunger.”

The Coulee Region Hunger Walk is an organization with the goal of providing food for families in need. The organization supports this goal with a yearly “Coulee Region Hunger Walk”. This year’s walk/run/bike will take place on Sunday, October 10, 2021 at 1:30 PM. WAFER and Hunger Task Force, two food relief agencies in the Coulee Region, will be the two main beneficiaries of the Walk.

The route for the 5 Km walk/run portion of the event will begin at Myrick Park Main Shelter and take the following route.

-Lg Shelter -Left on La Crosse St. -Right on 23rd St.

-Right on State St. -Left on 14th St. -Left on Cass St.

-Left on 23rd St. -Left on La Crosse St. -Right to the Main shelter

Bikers begin their ride at the Myrick Main Shelter, take the Marsh Trail to Riverside Park and return by the same route.

Hunger Task Force and WAFER each receive 30% of the proceeds from each participant. Participants may name another food relief organization to receive 40%. Those agencies include:
