## ORDINANCE NO.: 4748

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 8.02 (R) (1) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to change the number of bedrooms from 7 to 8 to be consistent with the definition of City serviced dwellings.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section  $8.02\,(\mathrm{R})\,(1)$  is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) The owner, designated agent or operator of any multiple family dwelling consisting of nine (9) or more bedrooms shall be required to provide a dumpster or dumpsters of appropriate size as specified by the City of La Crosse Building & Inspections Department or Refuse & Recycling Department for the deposit of refuse. The owner, designated agent or operator of any multiple family dwelling consisting of nine (9) or more bedrooms shall provide a proper sized permanently installed dumpster to eliminate any nuisance as may be determined by the City Building & Inspections Department or Refuse & Recycling Department. Refuse deposited in said dumpsters shall be collected and transported to a licensed disposal facility not less than once per week, and may be ordered to be dumped more frequently as deemed necessary by Refuse & Recycling or Building & Inspections Department at the expense of the property owner. In addition to the determination as to the size of the dumpster or dumpsters, the Building & Inspections Department is authorized to order relocation and/or screening or enclosure of any such required dumpster or dumpsters in order to eliminate any nuisance with respect to the same as may be determined by the City Building & Inspections Department. The owner, designated agent or operator of any multiple family dwelling unit consisting of four (4) to seven (7) eight (8) bedrooms shall be required to provide a dumpster if such owner or operator is cited twice or issued two Orders to Correct for violation of the City's recycling and refuse regulations within any twelve (12) month period.

 $\,$  SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
