To Whom This May Concern:


As property owners of 1370 CTH SS in the City of Onalaska, we strongly object to the proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

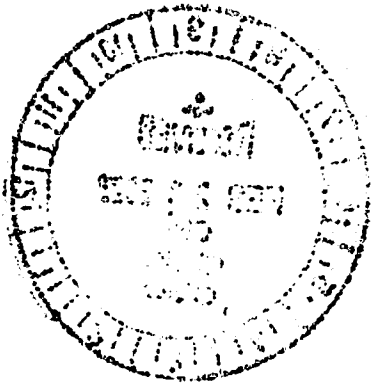
An ordinance to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the multiple dwelling district – heavy industrial district – Tax Parcel #17-10254-78.

The petition for change to zoning – amendment of zoning district boundaries is vague and does not include what the proposed used of the property will be used for. This rezoning would be very detrimental to the neighborhood and only increase the heavy industrial traffic on CTH SS. Noise and pollution would increase drastically.

Prior to owning 1370, we owned 1366 CTH SS for over 17 years. Our children were raised in a quiet residential area with sledding and snowmobiling and a peaceful backyard where quality family time was spent enjoying the wildlife, which would also be displaced.
