Public Information Meeting – Neighborhood Greenway 17th Street, from Farnam Street to State Street

Dear Resident/Owner:

The City of La Crosse is implementing its first Neighborhood Greenway (formerly Bike Boulevard), on 17th St, between Farnam St and State St. This project was first recommended in the citywide Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan in 2012. It was further developed through public outreach, including an interactive workshop in 2015. The Council approved the neighborhood greenway in the 2017 budget.

Neighborhood Greenway measures have been combined with utility and repaving projects, to minimize impacts and reduce costs. Some elements are:

- Bump-outs and painted crosswalks at Farnam, Adams, Winnebago, Market, and Ferry
- Pedestrian median islands with painted crosswalks and signs at Jackson
- · Neighborhood traffic circles at Johnson, Mississippi, Madison, and King
- Signs and painted crosswalks at Cass

Other routine city work to be done concurrently includes:

- Repaving streets between Jackson and Madison, and between King and State
- New water main between Jackson and Winnebago, and between Market and Ferry
- Upsized storm sewer between Main and State
- Sanitary sewer manhole repair and lining at King
