NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:  
AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Residence District to the Low Density Multiple District allowing four-unit condos on Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24 and 25 of Waterview Subdivision (Sunnyside Drive West and River Run Road).  
Proposed rezoning is necessary because: Current zoning does not allow for proposed use.
