

Application of The Gas Station LLC dba Fire Flower Hydro, 115 5th Ave. S. Unit B102, for a "Class A" Liquor License and Class "A" Beer License for license year July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 and Notice of Intent to Not Renew.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Gas Station LLC dba Fire Flower Hydro was granted a "Class A" Liquor License and a Class "A" Beer License on November 13, 2025, for the remainder of the license period ending June 30, 2026.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Code secs. 4-43 and 4-108 Commencing Operations, a licensee "shall be open for business with stock and equipment" within 90 days of the licenses being granted.

WHEREAS, The Gas Station LLC dba Fire Flower Hydro was in violation of Municipal Code secs. 4-43 and 4-108 for failure to commence operations within the required 90 days acknowledged by licensee.

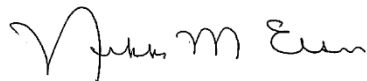
WHEREAS, on May 15, 2026, the City of La Crosse sought the nonrenewal of the alcohol license for failure to comply with Municipal Code secs. 4-43 and 4-108 and provided licensee with written Notice of Intent Not to Renew License with a nonrenewal hearing scheduled for June 2, 2026.

WHEREAS, following receipt of the Notice of Intent to Renew, Colleen Tompkins, agent of The Gas Station LLC, provided an Affidavit of Authenticity dated May 28, 2026 with records showing receipt purchase of alcohol stock from a qualified distributor and recent receipts showing retails sales of alcohol on the premise. The nonrenewal hearing was canceled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that based on the records provided showing recent license activity, it hereby approves the application of The Gas Station LLC dba Fire Flower Hydro for a "Class A" Liquor License and Class "A" Beer License at 115 5th Ave. S. Unit B102, for the license period 2026-27.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City staff is hereby directed to take all steps necessary in connection with this resolution.
