

Resolution authorizing use of capital equipment funds to renovate seven existing buses.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the La Crosse MTU is responsible for public mass transportation within the City of La Crosse boundaries and surrounding area in an efficient manner, with the public's safety being a top priority, and

WHEREAS, such responsibility includes relying on a fleet of buses in good state of repair, and

WHEREAS, Federal matching funds are unavailable for the procurement of new buses and the current fleet of City owned buses is aging, and

WHEREAS, the Transit Utility manager has recommended and secured vendor(s) to properly and efficiently structurally refurbish seven (7) currently owned buses, and


WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse MTU Board approved at its September 26, 2016 board meeting approved the use of previous years unspent capital funds to refurbish seven (7) currently owned buses as recommended by the Transit Utility Manager.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the Transit Utility Manager to use remaining Capital Equipment funds to commence the refurbishment of seven (7) City owned buses as needed to make them useable and safe for public transportation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for refurbishing costs be appropriated from Transit Capital Outlay 2011 4806405-586000-EQP11 \$28,029.04 Transit Capital Outlay 2013 4806405-586000-EQP13 up to \$221,970.96.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transit Manager and Director of Finance are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
