
Is housing discrimination keeping you out of a home?



HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

It is unlawful for any person to be denied housing on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry, age, disability, marital status, lawful source of income, physical appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, political activity, familial status or student status.

(City Ordinance Sec. 22-22)



La Crosse residents who believe they are the victim of housing discrimination may file a complaint with

the Human Rights Commission. A complaint form can be found online at cityoflacrosse.org/clerk. You may also file in person at City Hall at the City Clerk's office, 2nd floor, 400 La Crosse Street.

Housing Discrimination Examples

"You may want to live in this neighborhood instead."

"Because of your condition, we have to increase the rent."

"Only people who speak fluent English may live on this property"
