I was planning on attending the council meeting tonight, but unfortunately I had to stay home with a sick child. I would like to send in my written statement in favor of this agenda passing:

This total is only the majority of belongings damaged, and does not yet include cleaning and drying services, hauling damaged belongings to the dump, or cost to replace flooring, trim, and a bathroom vanity. This total also does not include damage to our property, as part of my driveway collapsed. Even with all the damage our house and property received, I know we made out ok compared to others who had more substantial flooding. It's crazy to me that I feel lucky to have only had 3 inches of mud and a sink hole in my driveway.

I have watched as the city has closed down and dug up Ward Ave to patch the water main multiple times in the last year, only to have this major break and flood occur with no one taking responsibility. The city needs to address this issue immediately, as our community cannot afford another break to happen again.
