The City of La Crosse is in receipt of Mayo Health System appeal of decision to designate the Professional Arts Building, 615 10th St. S. as a historic structure.

This is confirmation that the appeal is scheduled for public hearing before the Common Council on Thursday, April 9, 2026. The meeting is at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers on first floor of City Hall.

Pursuant to Municipal Code 20.58, the Common Council shall hold a public hearing on the appeal and may by majority vote of its members reverse or modify any decision of the Commission.

The appellant (either a representative of Mayo or you as counsel) will be allowed opportunity to address the Council prior to any public hearing. The Council will then open a public hearing allowing other speakers the opportunity to comment but public hearing rules will apply – 3 minutes per person and a total of 30 minutes if opposing viewpoints. If there are not opposing viewpoints, the public hearing will be limited to 15 minutes. Questions of the speakers do not count toward the time limitations.
