We would like to inform you and get your approval for a scope change due to removal of ten tree cells on 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Cass Street. These are being removed due to a utility conflict that cannot be quickly solved. With this information and removal at this time allows the eight tree cells on Main Street to be completed at no cost into this contract.

With this the change the contractor would like to extend the completion date to allow them to regroup and finish in the spring. Engineering staff approves this change to open the highway and avoid Wisconsin DOT from halting work due to extend closure time not requested.


### STREET PRIVILEGE PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR GAS / ELECTRIC UTILITY INSTALLATIONS

- The applicant shall be primarily liable for damages to person or property by reason of the granting of this street privilege permit.
- 2. The applicant shall obtain an excavation permit from the City of La Crosse Engineering Department prior to performing installation or any maintenance on the Utility in the City right-of-way that requires excavation or disruption of surface, pavement, sidewalk, curb and gutter, or other structure.
- 3. Applicant agrees to provide the City of La Crosse with final "as-built" plans when installation is complete.
- Applicant agrees that any pavement, concrete or green space disturbed during drilling activities shall be restored to its prior condition.
- 5. Applicant agrees that said installation shall not interfere with the City's water, sanitary sewer, or storm sewer underground infrastructure that may be in the area.
- 6. Applicant further agrees that they will make arrangements with the public utility companies and the City of La Crosse to clear all public underground utilities prior to initiating such work, and if necessary, applicant will make arrangements with the City of La Crosse to ensure proper traffic control.
- Applicant waives any and all rights to contest in any way or manner the validity of Sec. 66.0425 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the amount of compensation charged.
- 8. Applicant agrees to become a member of Diggers Hotline for marking / locating of utility.
- 9. The applicant for a permit to encroach on the public right-of-way shall procure and maintain for the duration of the permit a minimum liability and contractual liability policy in the amount of \$100,000.00 each person, \$300,000.00 each accident for bodily injury and \$100,000.00 for property damage. A certificate of such insurance shall be filed with the City Engineer as part of the application. The insurance shall name the City, its officials, employees and agents as additional insureds. The Board may approve greater insurance protection on a case-by-case basis.
- 10. Applicant further agrees to hold harmless the City for any damage to said Utility while the City, its agents or contractors are conducting construction for maintenance activities in or upon such area in which said utility lies; provided, however, the City shall make a good faith effort to notify applicant of any maintenance or work in the area of the street privilege permit which may damage applicant's utility.
- 11. Applicant agrees to remove the utility and return the area to its original condition upon ten (10) days' notice by the Board of Public Works. The applicant further agrees that if it does not remove the utility within ten (10) days after receiving notice, the City is authorized to remove the same and applicant agrees to pay the City for all costs of such removal.
- 12. Applicant further agrees that the obligations and conditions of this street privilege permit shall be binding upon all heirs, successors and assigns of applicant.
- 13. The person(s) signing this Permit warrant that they have the authority to sign as, or on behalf of, the party for whom they are signing.
