ORDINANCE NO. 5329

AN ORDINANCE to amend section 105-25. (b) (5) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to update code language regarding required inspections of construction site erosion control.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 105-25. (b) (5) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(5) Make periodic Perform inspections of sites per the MS4 permit to verify implementation of approved erosion and sediment control plans and to enforce permit conditions.

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
