Per your request during our telephone conversation please find attached the following documents with brief summary explaining what information it is intended to show or provide;

- Figure 1 proposed footprint for expansion: This figure shows the current proposed footprint location for the expansion. This is used for the WDNR permitting process to outline the current extent of the proposed cell limits. Note it does not include any parcel or location criteria, but is intended to show footprint with existing features.

- LAX CO GIS Parcel map expansion area: This figure is from the County's GIS site and is provided to show the approximate outline of the expansion footprint with respect to the parcels affected. Note the parcels include one parcel located in the City of La Crosse (17-10575-10), and two parcels located in the City of Onalaska (18-4462-0 and 18-4463-0).

- DNR Print Template Qt-Qt Section Location: This figure is from the State's Location Finder website and is provided to focus in on the quarter-quarter section included in the proposed expansion. As indicated on the figure, the parcel within the City of La Crosse jurisdiction (17-10575-10), and one of the parcels with the City of Onalaska's jurisdiction ( 18-4463-0) are located in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, T16N, R7W. The other parcel located in the City of Onalaska jurisdiction (18-4462-0) is located in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, T16N, R7W.
