

Resolution establishing the Outdoor Café Program.

AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in response to the impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has had on restaurants in our community, the City of La Crosse is committed to assisting businesses; and

WHEREAS, temporarily allowing restaurants to expand their outdoor seating will aid in the recovery of the local economy while adhering to Public Health Orders from the La Crosse County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, some restaurants have previously approved sidewalk cafes or outdoor eating areas in which they will be able to resume serving customers while adhering to Public Health Orders from the La Crosse County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, these restaurants may wish to expand their existing sidewalk cafes or outdoor eating areas in order to serve more customers outside while adhering to Public Health Orders from the La Crosse County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, other restaurants ~~and taverns~~ without existing sidewalk cafes or outdoor eating areas may wish to establish or expand such spaces in private parking lots accessory to the establishment, or on the sidewalk, or in the public street, or on an adjacent property; and

WHEREAS, certain City ordinances related to sidewalk café licenses and outdoor eating areas, including street vending, zoning, alcohol licensing, and street occupancy either prohibit these activities or subject them to lengthy approval processes.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby establishes the Outdoor Café Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse adopts the Outdoor Café Program Guidelines and application materials as amended, with the direction to staff to update the Guidelines to include bars, restaurants and tasting rooms as a part of the Outdoor Café Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Outdoor Café Program sunsets on November 13, 2020. Any extension of this date or renewal of the program will have to be brought back before the Common Council for action.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning & Development Department, the City Clerk, the Engineering & Public Works Department and the Fire Department Division of Community Risk Management are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
