

Resolution approving historical pedestrian street lighting standards in the 10<sup>th</sup> and Cass National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) District.

AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, residents in the 10<sup>th</sup> & Cass District and surrounding blocks wanted different street lighting standard than were used in other city street lighting projects;

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED, the Common Council of the City of La Crosse hereby approves the following standards as proposed in the attached Historical Lighting study by Schuler Shook in the 10<sup>th</sup> & Cass NRHP District:

Light Pole Type	Ornamental Decorative
Light Pole Height	<u>Ten (10) to Twelve (12) Feet</u>
Luminaire	Post Top
Light Color	<del>3K</del> <u>2700 to 3000</u>
Range of Lighting Level	<del>Minimum 0.1-0.0</del> <u>to 0.5 Foot Candle Avg.</u>
Lamp Type	LED
Pole Color	<del>Semi-Gloss Black</del>
Light Pole Spacing	<del>Varies (150' +/- 25')</del> <u>(85-125' +/- 10')</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following blocks shall use the standards as approved in this resolution:

- 700, 800, 900 and 1000 and 1100 Blocks of King Street
- 900 Block of Cameron Street
- 100, 200 and 300 Blocks of 10<sup>th</sup> Street South
- 200 Block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street South
- 200 block of 8<sup>th</sup> Street South

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above standards may be used in the blocks surrounding the 10<sup>th</sup> & Cass Historic District and bounded by the north side of State Street, the west side of West Avenue, the south side of Cameron Avenue, and the east side of 7<sup>th</sup> Street as requested by the neighborhood and approved by the Board of Public Works.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Director of Engineering and Public Works, Deputy Director of Engineering and Public Works and the Superintendent of Streets are hereby authorized to effectuate this resolution.
