This is our counter offer for A-1 Excavating's claims for costs associated with delays. A-1 is claiming 13 weeks of delays in the amount of \$97,500.00.

A-1 is claiming 3 weeks delay for not having the storm outfall permit in place. We accept their claim and propose to compensate them the value of Bid Item 21 as follows:
