

Resolution approving termination of the Water and Fire Service Agreement for the property located at 129 Clinton Street in the Town of Campbell.

### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse and Town of Campbell entered into a WATER AND FIRE SERVICE AGREEMENT, dated December 8, 2005, that allowed retail water service and special firefighting and equipment service to non-residential properties in the Town, and

WHEREAS, the WATER AND FIRE SERVICE AGREEMENT required individual contracts between the City, Town and property owners which authorized these services, and

WHEREAS, there is an individual contract, recorded June 8, 2006, for water and fire service for the property located at 129 Clinton Street; Tax ID No. 4-859-0, and

WHEREAS, the water service originally installed to this property was disconnected and capped in June 2016, and

WHEREAS, the City received a communication, dated January 16, 2018, from an attorney representing the current owner of the property, requesting that the contract for retail water service and special firefighting and equipment service for the subject property be terminated.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, that it hereby approves the termination of the contract for retail water service and special firefighting and equipment service for the property located at 129 Clinton Street (Tax ID No. 4-859-0) with the termination being conditioned upon the following occurring within 90 days:

- (1) The Town of Campbell Board shall take similar action to approve the termination of the contract for the subject property, and
- (2) The 2016 special charge for fire-fighting and equipment services shall be paid in full.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney, Utilities Manager, Fire Chief, and City Clerk are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
