

Resolution appropriating additional TID and Utility funds for professional services as part of the Causeway Boulevard reconstruction project, construction administration and inspection.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse previously awarded a contract for reconstruction of Causeway Boulevard, from the western terminus to Copeland Avenue, with Res. 23-1386; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse entered into a professional services agreement with SEH as part of the CIP project (#173) for construction administration and inspection, to more efficiently coordinate the work with the adjacent River Point District (RPD) development; and

WHEREAS, the phasing of the RPD development (Phase II) required Causeway Boulevard construction to occur in multiple years to ensure access to local businesses and properties, resulting in a longer contract time and more complex staging, and additional funds are required for the professional services to deliver this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes use of additional funding for necessary professional services as part of CIP #173 (Causeway Boulevard).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council authorizes use of funding *from*:

TID 18 #173 (construction contingency)	\$65,000
2025 Sanitary Sewer Utility Unbudgeted Cash	\$75,000
2025 Water Utility Unbudgeted Cash	\$15,000

And allocating those funds *to*:

CIP #173, Agreement for Professional Services	\$155,000
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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City departments and staff are hereby authorized to effectuate this resolution.
