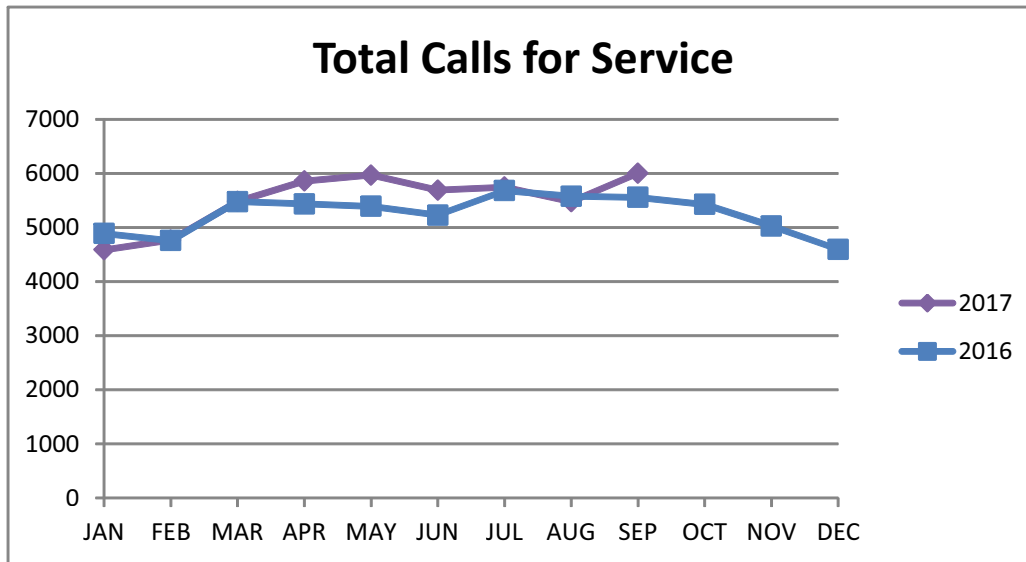

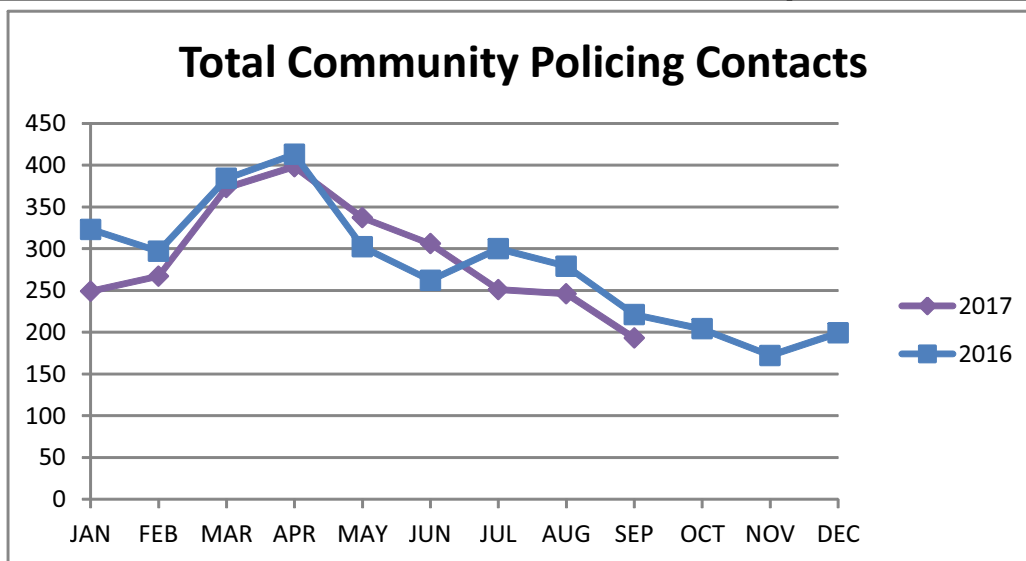
YTD through September 2017
