TYPE OF ALTERATION: No Parking, here to corner

GENERAL LOCATION: West side of the 200 block 29<sup>th</sup> Street South, from the north side of  
Ebner Coulee Rd/Cass St to a point 200 feet northerly thereof.

Report:

A request was received from the Police Parking Utility to investigate the 200 block of 29<sup>th</sup> Street South for No Parking near the intersection with Cass Street/Ebner Coulee Rd.

It is hereby noted that there is increased pedestrian and parking activity in the area due to the new La Crosse trailhead. The additional No Parking Zone will preserve visibility and safety approaching the intersection of Cass St/Ebner Coulee Rd. It is therefore recommended to establish No Parking Zone in the 200 block of 29<sup>th</sup> St S as defined above on the West side of the street.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

- No Parking, Here to the Corner in the 200 block of 29<sup>th</sup> Street S, as detailed above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
