AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Traditional Neighborhood District - General to the Traditional Neighborhood District - Specific allowing a mixed use development.
Property is proposed to be used for: A four-story mixed use retail commercial and residential building.
