

ORDINANCE NO.5291

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and recreate Section 2-31(b) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to update ward boundaries and Aldermanic Districts following state legislative redistricting decision.

WHEREAS, in 2021, the City redistricted following the 2020 census and adopted a ward plan and aldermanic districts; and

WHEREAS, since redistricting, new legislative maps were approved splitting the City into Assembly Districts 94, 95, and 96; and

WHEREAS, the new assembly district boundaries created various ward splits throughout the City, and per state law, wards cannot be split; and

WHEREAS, the May 2024 Aldermanic District map depicts the adjusted boundaries to accommodate the splits so that wards are entirely in one assembly district; and

WHEREAS, aldermanic district legal descriptions will be codified in the Municipal Code.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 2-31 (b) is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

- (b) Boundaries. The Aldermanic Districts shall be numbered and bounded as set forth below.

District 1	Wards 1, 2, 27
District 2	Wards 3, 4
District 3	Wards 5, 6
District 4	Wards 7, 8
District 5	Wards 9, 10
District 6	Wards 11, 12
District 7	Wards 17, 18
District 8	Wards 15, 16, 28
District 9	Wards 13, 14
District 10	Wards 19, 20
District 11	Wards 21, 22
District 12	Wards 23, 24
District 13	Wards 25, 26

The May 2024 Aldermanic District map is available in the City Clerk’s Office or on the Legislative Information Center searching File 24-0617.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
