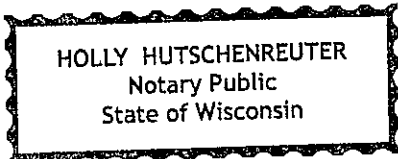

NOTICE OF HEARING ON AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on its proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:  
AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse, transferring certain property from the Traditional Neighborhood District General to the Traditional Neighborhood District Specific; allowing mixed-use development, at 1222 Danton St.  
Property is presently used for Vacant, former Southside Senior Center.  
Property is proposed to be used for Mixed-use.  
Proposed rezoning is necessary because the structure is currently going through the process to become a historic structure and rezoning will help preserve the building.  
Said property is further described as follows:
