Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing upon the application of **Mayo Clinic Health System – Franciscan Medical Center for the issuance of a Conditional Use Permit under Sec. 115-353** of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse **allowing demolition of existing buildings for construction of a parking lot.**

Said property is generally located at **1001-1007 Jackson St. and 930 11<sup>th</sup> St. S.** and is further described as follows:

Final action will be determined by the **Common Council on Thursday, August 8, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers in City Hall in the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

You are further notified that any person affected may be heard, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection form is available in the office of the City Clerk.

An opaque privacy fence of a minimum of five feet and no more than eight feet in height may be required in residential zoned districts if requested by an abutting residential property owner. Such fence shall be placed on the property line and shall run from the front set back line to the rear property line.

The application and supporting documentation may be examined in the Office of the City Clerk, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of City Hall, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on any regular business day, holidays excepted, or in the Legislative Information Center which can be accessed from the City website at [www.cityoflacrosse.org](http://www.cityoflacrosse.org).
