

Coulee Region Hunger Walk

“We walk with our neighbors to end hunger.”

The Coulee Region Hunger Walk is an organization with the goal of providing food for families in need. The organization supports this goal with a yearly “Coulee Region Hunger Walk”. This year’s walk will take place on Sunday, October 13, 2019 at 1 PM. This 5km walk will originate and end at Myrick Park. WAFER and Hunger Task Force, two food relief agencies in the Coulee Region, will be the two main beneficiaries of the Walk. Last year these agencies distributed over 3 million pounds of food. Walkers can also name another non-profit food relief program to receive part of that walker’s proceeds.

The walk will originate from the large shelter in Myrick Park, proceed West on La Crosse Street toward Lang Drive, walk North on Lang Drive, exit Lang Drive by the bridge and take the Marsh Trail going Southeast back to the main shelter at Myrick Park.
