A Charter ORDINANCE to amend Section 2.18(A) of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to reduce the membership of the Municipal Transit Utility Board.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 2.18(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 2.18 MUNICIPAL TRANSIT UTILITY.
 - (A) MEMBERSHIP.

The Municipal Transit Utility Board shall consist of the following members:

The Mayor of the City of La Crosse;

- (1) (2) One (1) Council Member representing The the Board of Public Works as defined in Section 2.08 of this Code, as amended or superseded; to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council for a term of two (2) years to coincide with the term served on the Board of Public Works;
- (2) (3) Two One (1) unpaid citizen residents of the City, preferably persons who regularly utilize or ride the Municipal Transit Utility buses, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council for a term of two (2) years beginning on the first day in September 1988; upon approval of this amended ordinance;
- (3) One resident or non resident La Crosse County Board Supervisor, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council for a term of two (2) years or until the end of his/her elected term on the County Board, whichever is earlier;
- (4) An-One (1) unpaid student representative from each to serve on behalf of all three of the City's institutions of higher education, which currently consist of three (3) institutions, said student representatives shall serve for an initial term commencing upon the effective date of this ordinance through May 31, 2008. Upon expiration of the initial term, the term shall be for one (1) year beginning on June 1, 2008 and each year thereafter. - University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, Western Technical College and Viterbo University. The Mayor shall appoint the student representative, subject to confirmation by the Council, for a one (1) year term that will rotate on a yearly basis between the three (3) higher education institutions - the UWL representative will serve one year from May 31, 2011; the WTC representative from May 31, 2012, the Viterbo representative from May 31, 2013, and so on. Said representative in this subsection need not be a resident of the City of La Crosse, but must be recommended by the respective higher education institution . The student government of each institution shall submit its recommendation of a single candidate

for appointment, if any, to the City no later than the first day of May immediately preceding the commencement of the student representative's term for review by the Council prior to final confirmation of each respective year.

- (5) The Mayors, or designees, of the cities of Onalaska, Wisconsin and La Crescent, Minnesota and the Chairperson, or designee, of the Town of Campbell, Wisconsin as voting members; provided, such communities continue to have fixed route service. Said members in this subsection need not be residents of the City of La Crosse.
- (6) Other communities or municipalities that have a contract with the La-Crosse Municipal Transit Utility and receive service from the Transit Utility may appoint an unpaid additional non-voting member to the Municipal Transit Utility Board who may be a member of the governing body of such other community or a citizen of such other community. The term of such other community non-voting member shall be for two (2) years unless such other community service contract with the La-Crosse Municipal Transit Utility terminates and is not renewed within any two (2) year term.
- (7) Three (3) unpaid alternates to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The first alternate shall act, with full power, only when a voting member of the Municipal Transit Utility Board in absent. The second and subsequent alternates shall so act only upon the absence of multiple voting members or the first or preceding alternate. This paragraph shall expire on May 21, 2009.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
